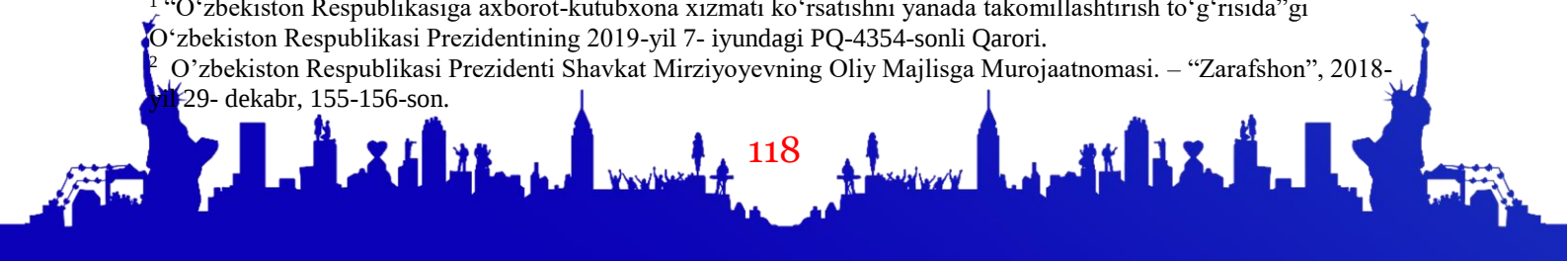

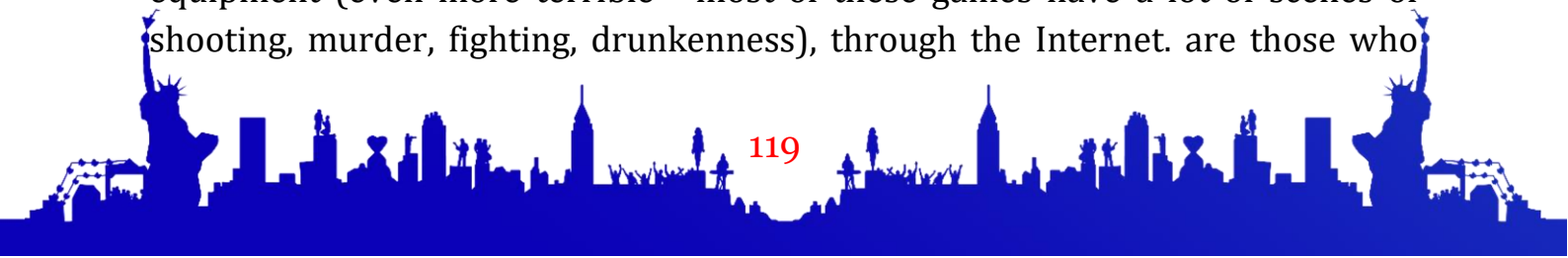


our head of state admitted, is rapidly moving from national recovery to national growth.

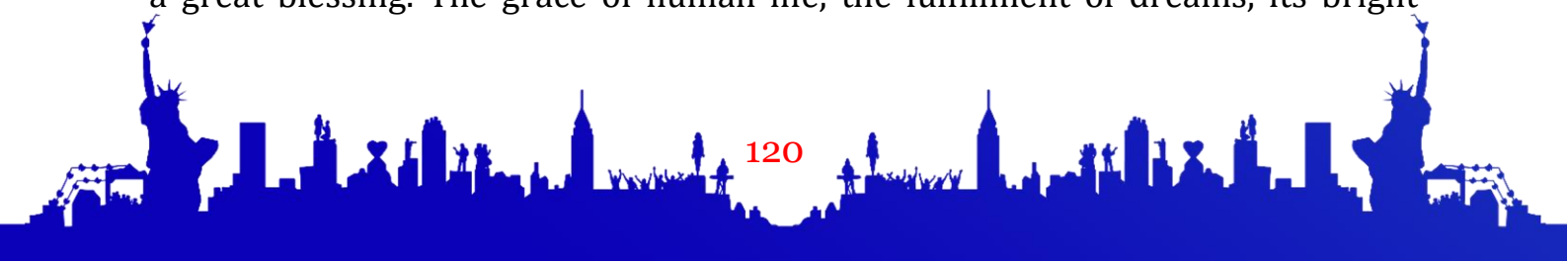


have downloaded but are becoming ardent fans of movies and photos that are not appropriate for their age.

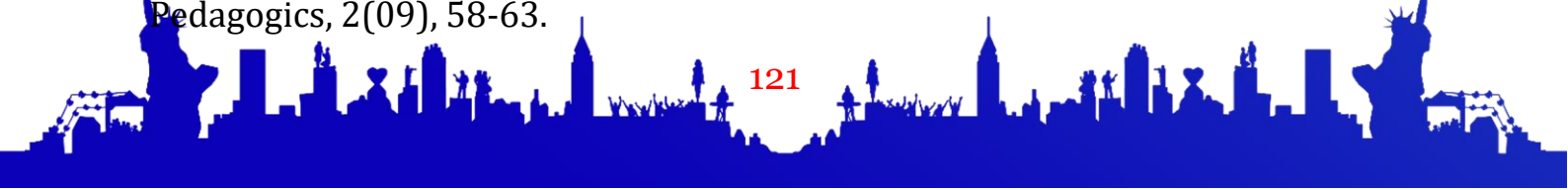
future. Life without children is not good for anyone. For every parent, a child is more dear and proud with his manners, discipline, and spiritual maturity.
