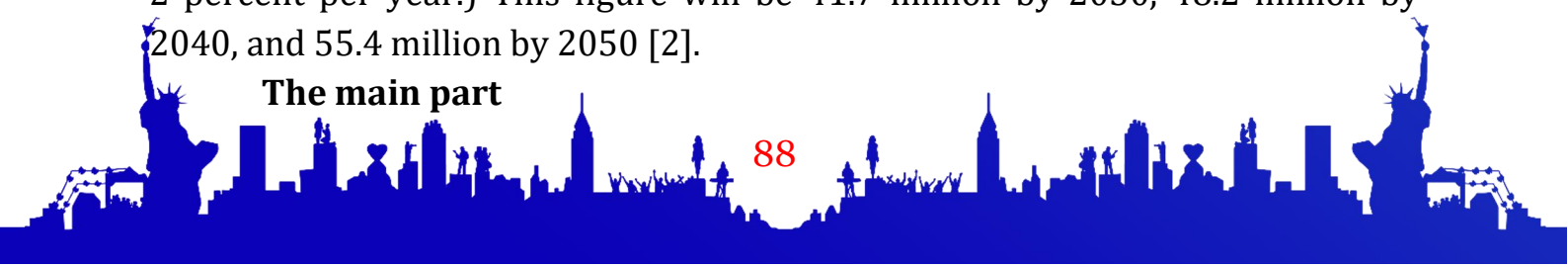
Today's rapidly developing times require every country to conduct a strong and fair policy in the social and economic spheres.

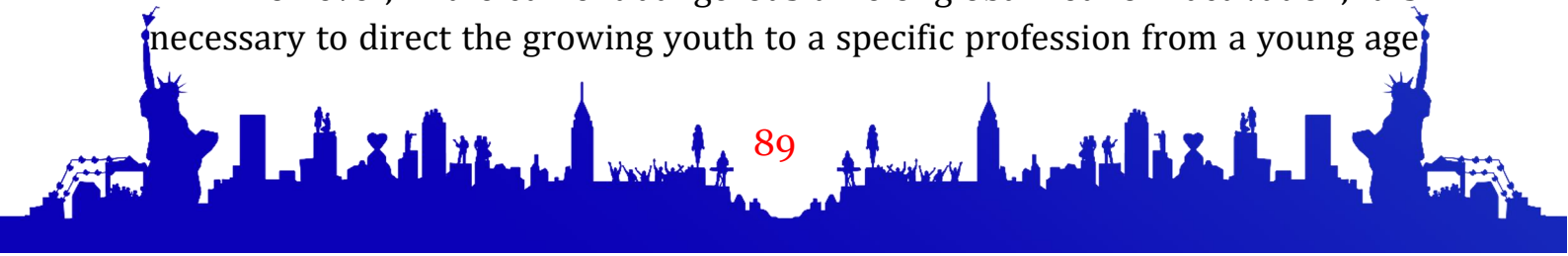

In this context, the following factors related to the labor of minors are relevant today:

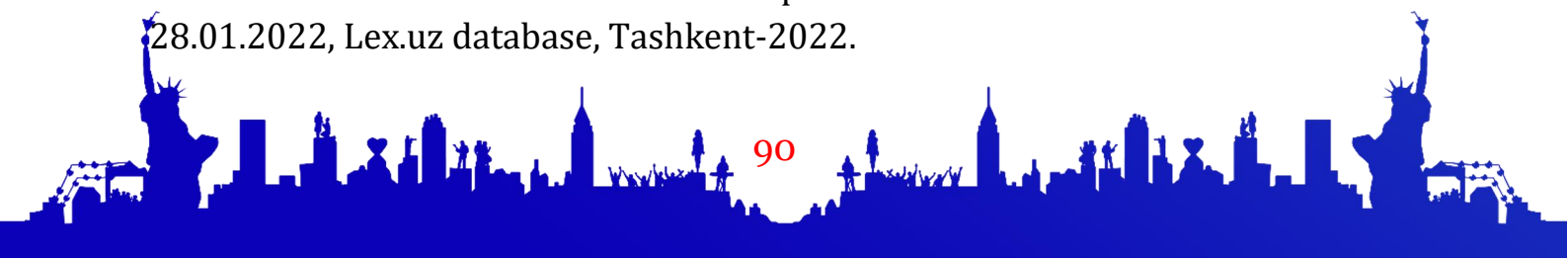
- that minors cannot fully use their labor rights;
